SR – Regimental CO/XO/S-1/S-2/S-3/S-33/S-35/S-37/S-4/S-5/S-6, Battalion CO/XO/S-1/S-2/S-3/S-4/S-5/S-6, Company CO/XO, Regimental IG, Regimental Recruiting Officer, Honor Court Chief Justice, Staff Judge Advocate, Growley Captain, Color Guard Commander, Drum Major, ROTC Battalion/Wing Commander.

Note: Other ROTC leadership positions do not count for this requirement. Cadets relieved from duty may not count that position for with distinction.

Corps Activity Points:

- Regimental or Battalion Staff NCO = 4 pts per position
 - Regimental Special Staff Officer or NCO = 3 pts per position
 - Platoon Leader/Platoon Sgt = 3 pts per position
 - Gregory Guard Commander/1SG = 3 pts per year
 - Skipper Gun Captain/Chief of Smoke = 3 pts per year
 - Color Guard Member = 3 pts per year
 - Cadre Sergeant = 3 pts
 - Leadership position (listed below or equivalent) in a Corps Organization = 2 pts per year per organization
 - o President/OIC
 - o Vice President/AOIC/NCOIC
 - o Secretary/Clerk/Treasurer
 - o Recruiting/Operations Officer
 - Weeks of Welcome Leader or CTA = 2 pts
 - Summer Orientation Leader = 5 pts
 - Serve as Corps Tutor at least 8 times in a semester = 2 pts per semester
 - Participate in a study abroad opportunity (Global Scholars, Project GO, Olmsted Scholars, VT Study Abroad, etc.) = 5 pts per opportunity
 - Attend a Rice Center sponsored Leadership Conference = 2 pts per conference
 - Participate in planning and executing VTCC Ethics in Leadership Conference = 10 pts
 - Participate in planning and executing Corps Homecoming/Alumni engagement = 5 pts per engagement
 - Participate in planning and executing of the Spend the Night program (just hosting a prospective student does not earn these points) = 2 pts per semester
 - Win Eager Squad or Eager Individual = 5 pts per win
- Other activities as coordinated with the Director of the Rice Center for Leader Development = points vary.
